

## **2018-19 AMERICORPS POSITION SUMMARIES**

### **CAMP ELSO – PROGRAM & OUTREACH COORDINATOR**

Empower youth of color to explore the possibilities of careers in science fields by exposing them to unique outdoor learning opportunities while nurturing a love for the outdoors.

### **CITY OF GRESHAM, SOLID WASTE – COMMUNITY OUTREACH SPECIALIST**

Encourage recycling with property managers and multifamily communities by providing direct education via door-to-door outreach and tabling events. Support schools to become Oregon Green Schools.

### **CITY OF PORTLAND, BUREAU OF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES – STORMWATER OUTREACH COORDINATOR**

Recruit and train community volunteers in Green Street plantings and stewardship for maximum environmental benefits in low-income, racially diverse communities.

### **CITY OF PORTLAND, BUREAU OF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES – TREE EQUITY COORDINATOR**

Plan and develop urban forest and sustainable stormwater capacity in low-canopy, low-income communities and communities of color in Portland.

### **CLACKAMAS COUNTY, RESOURCE CONSERVATION – WASTE REDUCTION SPECIALIST**

Provide recycling/ waste reduction education in multifamily communities, through relationship building, food waste prevention education and developing inclusive resources to underserved communities.

### **CLEAN WATER SERVICES – WATER RESOURCE TECHNICIAN**

Educate community members about watershed health, and promote stewardship in stream and wetland restoration projects. Conduct targeted outreach to engage more underserved and diverse neighborhoods.

### **COLUMBIA SLOUGH WATERSHED COUNCIL – HABITAT RESTORATION EDUCATOR**

Lead High School youth mentors and elementary students through a habitat restoration program where projects focus on classroom lesson support, restoration site surveys and event preparation.

### **COLUMBIA SLOUGH WATERSHED COUNCIL/NADAKA NATURE PARK – EVENT & OUTREACH SPECIALIST**

Facilitate event logistics, conduct outreach and engage volunteers in flat-water paddle events. Provide multi-lingual information, promote inclusivity, and engage community to improve park safety.

### **FORTH MOBILITY FUND – COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT SPECIALIST**

Interact with employer organizations, municipalities, community partners, and the public to help promote the use of electric vehicle and EV charging infrastructure.

### **JOHNSON CREEK WATERSHED COUNCIL – OUTREACH & RIPARIAN SPECIALIST**

Plan and implement restoration projects, community science programs, volunteer events, and environmental education for watershed residents from underserved communities.

### **NATIONAL WILDLIFE FEDERATION/ASSOCIATION OF NORTHWEST STEELHEADERS – EDUCATION & OUTREACH COORDINATOR**

Promote environmental justice by engaging communities, schools, and partners in opportunities that help develop stewardship, increase access to outdoors and restores/protects wildlife habitat.

#### **PORTLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE, SYLVANIA – LEARNING GARDEN COORDINATOR**

Establish systems that supply fresh produce to low-income students experiencing food insecurity and provide education in the Learning Garden on organic food production, planting and sustainability.

#### **REYNOLDS LEARNING ACADEMY – ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRAM SPECIALIST**

Organize and coordinate recruitment and environmental education opportunities to engage students from diverse backgrounds. Develop bilingual materials to meet the needs of second language learners.

#### **THE BLUEPRINT FOUNDATION – DIVERSE ENGAGEMENT SPECIALIST**

Identify job opportunities to assist Black students in securing internships prior to graduation and create a mentoring program that connects students to Black professionals in various careers.

#### **THE NATURE CONSERVANCY – COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT COORDINATOR**

Engage and activate more Oregonians in conservation work: help design, build and implement urban engagement programs, including restoration and outreach programs targeted to an urban audience.

#### **TRASH FOR PEACE – SUSTAINABILITY EDUCATION COORDINATOR**

Educate youth and community about sustainability through hands-on learning. Help to implement, improve, and expand Education Program that serves to economically and socially empower participants.

#### **US FISH & WILDLIFE SERVICES/OREGON ZOO – WILDLIFE CONSERVATION EDUCATOR**

Provide conservation education at the Oregon Zoo focused on reaching under-served populations. Develop educational kits and activities and conduct outreach to build partnerships within the community.

#### **VERDE – ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION SPECIALIST**

Create an environmental education program to serve low-income youth and youth of color in the Cully neighborhood. Develop curriculum, strengthen partnerships, recruit volunteers and conduct outreach.

#### **WASHINGTON COUNTY SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING – WASTE REDUCTION OUTREACH SPECIALIST**

Implement a waste prevention project for multifamily communities. Offer technical assistance to managers that include educational materials, presentations, outreach and tabling.

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#### **CITY OF GRESHAM, PARKS & RECREATION – URBAN ECOLOGY OUTREACH SPECIALIST (2 POSITIONS - 900 HOUR)**

Develop an encroachment management plan by reviewing existing information, data collection and analysis, and community outreach. Coordinate riparian restoration events and volunteer activities.

#### **METRO PARKS & NATURE, VOLUNTEER SERVICES – COMMUNITY CREW LEADER (900 HOUR)**

Lead volunteer activities and restoration projects that engage racially and economically diverse communities. Design evaluation tools that use community feedback to better engage volunteers.
