### **CASCADE RELIEF TEAM**

#### **VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR**

Provide research and insight into the disaster recovery process, source resources and volunteers for the community impacted, and co-chair the Volunteer Management Committee for Clackamas County.

### **CLACKAMAS COUNTY, SUSTAINABILITY & SOLID WASTE**

#### **WASTE REDUCTION SPECIALIST**

Provide recycling/waste reduction education in multifamily communities, through relationship building, food waste prevention education and developing inclusive resources to underserved communities.

### **GREATER OREGON CITY WATERSHED COUNCIL**

#### **STEWARDSHIP INVOLVEMENT COORDINATOR**

Bring habitat restoration and watershed health to the community of Oregon City through hands-on engagement and reaching out to under-served community members of the watersheds where we work.

#### **COMMUNITY OUTREACH COORDINATOR**

#### **EDUCATION & OUTREACH COORDINATOR**

Promote environmental justice by engaging communities and partners in opportunities that help develop stewardship, increase access to outdoors and restores/protects wildlife habitat.

#### **LEARNING GARDEN COORDINATOR**
